Who can have a stall?

Under 16s who live in the Kempsey Shire can showcase and sell their products for free at Kempsey Riverside Markets.

A minimum age limit may apply – this will be decided when reviewing application

Does it cost anything to have a stall using the MMMM?

It's free - there are no stall fees.

What can I sell?

Handmade products could be anything from silly slime, jewellery, artwork, pottery, candles, Show us what you've got we'd love to support you

What do I need to do?

- Request and fill in an application form tell us about you and your handmade products
- 2. We will get back to you about if/when you can use the stall*
- 3. On the day you use the stall, you will need to:
 - a. Bring all your products and do all set-up and pack up of your goods
 - b. Provide and manage their own cash float for sales (and/or portable EFT payment device)
 - c. Always have a responsible adult present while you are at the markets

*There is only one stall each month, so we will create a waiting list (based on order applications are received) and people will be offered the stall on a rotational basis, depending how much interest we get.

Where you might wish to share the stall with another mini maker you know, please include this in the application (you may need to bring additional table/s).
